**Guelph - Community Engagement Associate (1 available, 8 weeks/35 hrs per week, \$14/hour):** The Community Engagement Associate is responsible for supporting the implementation of the Fundraising and Marketing Team's community outreach and events strategy. The participant will be integral to research, marketing, and event preparation in lead up to our Home Dedication Celebration, Ultimate Celebrity Chef Crawl, and Ultimate Habitat House Party events.

**Guelph - ReStore Warehouse/Truck Associate (1 available, 8 weeks/35 hrs per week, \$14/hour):** The ReStore Warehouse/Truck Associate provides customers and donors with an incredible experience that fosters returning relationships to maximize revenue through exceptional customer service, merchandising, effective pick-up/receiving/processing of product donations, and salvage/recycling. The position also supports the ReStore truck operations by attending off-site pick-ups and salvage operations with a staff and volunteer salvage crew. This opportunity requires customer service, merchandising, teamwork, flexibility, adaptability, and communication skills.

**Positions in Guelph, Fergus & Orangeville - ReStore Associate (2 available at each of the three locations, 8 weeks/35 hrs per week, \$14/hour):** The ReStore Associate works in the ReStore. - Habitat for Humanity ReStores are home and building supply stores that accept and resell quality new and used building materials, furniture, appliances, home accessories, and much more. Responsibilities include: processing payment for items on a cash register, assisting customers with their shopping experience, stocking and arranging the sales floor, cleaning the sales area, and participating in reaching the sales goals of the ReStore.

**Orangeville - Studio Associate (1 available, 8 weeks/35 hrs per week, \$14/hour):** The Studio Associate undertakes a leadership position in the Orangeville ReStore Studio, a place where product donations are up-cycled, repurposed, and upgraded for resale at the ReStore. The Studio Associate works with corporate and community volunteers to complete projects in the Studio. They will also focus on raising the profile of the Studio within the Orangeville community; promoting its role in environmental awareness, affordable housing, and the Habitat mission.
